The QEP logo, developed by Ms. Janet Kelly, does a great job of describing what we want the QEP to do for student learning at Middle Georgia Tech. Improving student learning in math will impact students from every program on campus. If we can build the QEP effectively, improvements in student learning will stretch all over campus beyond the math classroom and into program courses, too! We are hopefully talking about a school-wide cultural change in the way we approach math in each of our classrooms and eventually an improvement in the math skills of our graduates.

### Three QEP Programs

The QEP contains three programs: Building Math Bridges, SurvivorMath, and Lighthouse. Building Math Bridges will be focused on contextualizing math instruction; SurvivorMath will focus on communities of learning, and Lighthouse will be a program of professional development for faculty in the area of math instruction.

### What is the focus of the QEP?

- ◇ Improved student learning in the math portions of program courses
- ◇ Improved math preparation for the workplace
